Cutting Instructions: WOFLLOF = Width of Fabric/Length of Fabric
From the Cloudcover (A), cut:
-(1) $271 / 2 " \times 321 / 2 "$ ( $69.85 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) LOF strip.
From the Cosmic Scatter (B), cut:
-(2) 2 " $\times 321 / 2 "(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm})$ WOF strips.
-(2) 2 " $\times 301 / 2 \prime$ " $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm})$ WOF strips.

- See instructions to cut (1) Balloon Interior, (1) Basket, and (1) Balloon Segment \#5.
-(5) $21 / 2 \prime$ " $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips for binding.
From the My Little Star (C), cut:
- See instructions to cut (1) Balloon Segment \#4.

From the Nebulae (D), cut:
-(9) $3^{\prime \prime}$ ( 7.62 cm ) x WOF strips. Sub-cut (120) 3" squares.

## From the Rocket Dance (E), cut:

- See instructions to cut (1) Balloon Segment \#2.


## From the Saturn's Path (F), cut:

- See instructions to cut (1) Balloon Base and (1) Basket Trim.

From the Sky High (G), cut:

- See instructions to cut (1) Balloon Segment \#1.

From the Treasures in the Sky (H), cut:

- (5) $51 / 2 "$ " 13.97 cm ) x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $51 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ ( 13.97 cm ) squares.
- See instructions to cut (1) Balloon Segment \#3.

From the My Little Star (Back), cut:
-(2) 48 " (122cm) x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $48^{\prime \prime} \times 53^{\prime \prime}(122 \mathrm{~cm} \times 135 \mathrm{~cm})$ back.

## Sewing Instructions:

Sew using a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise indicated.

1. Place (1) $3^{\prime \prime}(7.62 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $D$ square on the top left corner of (1) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric H square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4 "(0.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ away from the sewn seam.
2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 3 " ( 7.62 cm ) Fabric $D$ square to each of the remaining corners of the $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ( 13.97 cm ) Fabric H square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (30) Block One squares total.

4. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}(0.32 \mathrm{~cm})$ outside the drawn lines.
5. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
6. Refer to Figure 5 to arrange and press the balloon basket and balloon segments onto the $271 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 321 / 2^{\prime \prime}(69.85 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric A strip.
7. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch. Add decorative stitching from the balloon to the basket and on the balloon to make The Center Block.

## Quilt Top Assembly: Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.

8. Sew (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 321 / 2^{\prime \prime}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 301 / 2 "(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (7) Block One squares together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.
10. Sew (8) Block One squares together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
