Fabric Requirements (Version #1):

Festive Fair – Fat Quarter Bundle A	1 Bundle	0166FQ-FF-A
Candy Cane Stripe - Green (A)		01667347B

You will also need:

- (2) pieces of batting 35cm x 55cm for each stocking
- Basic sewing supplies and tools
- *Optional:* (1) 16cm piece of ribbon or twine for the hanger for each stocking

Cutting Instructions (Version #1): WOF/LOF = Width of Fabric/Length of Fabric

From the Candy Cane Stripe - Green (A), cut:

- (30) Diamonds from template.

Gingerbread Delight - Red (B), cut:

- (48) Diamonds from template.

Gingerbread Delight - Green (C), cut:

- (14) Hexagons from template.

Toy Tree - Teal (D), cut:

- (20) Hexagons from template.

Sweet Surprise - Multi (E), cut:

- (20) Diamonds from template.

Festive Flora - Green (F), cut:

- (1) Stocking Template 1 piece and (1) Stocking Template 2 piece.
- (2) Cuff Template 1 pieces and (2) Cuff Template 2 pieces.

Sewing Instructions (Version #1):

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " (0.64cm) seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise indicated. Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Use the method of your choice listed below to prepare the listed number of Hexagons and Diamonds for the stocking of your choice.

- Sewing Method-Center and pin the cardstock template to the center of each fabric shape on the wrong side of the fabric. Fold over the fabric edge around the card stock and hand baste in place (Fig. 1).
- Gluing Method- Using a washable glue stick, center and glue the cardstock template to the center of each fabric shape on the wrong side of the fabric. Fold over the fabric edge around the card stock and glue in place with the glue stick.

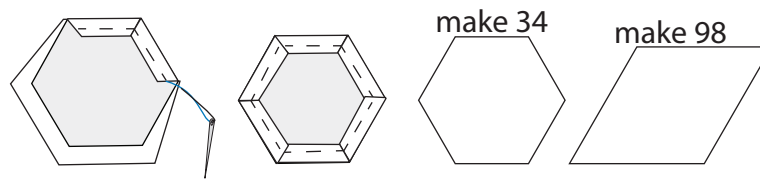

2. Place the first (2) Diamonds, right sides together aligning the edges. Start hand sewing the pieces together along the edges by placing two pieces right sides together and whip stitching them together, just catching the edges of the fabric. Recommended 6-10 stitches per inch (Fig 2).

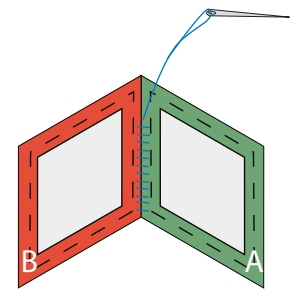

3. Follow Figures 3-13 to make the indicated number of each unit for Unit 1 through Unit 11.

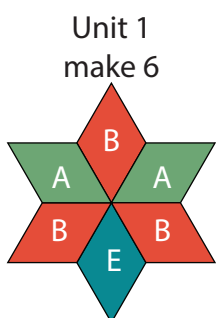

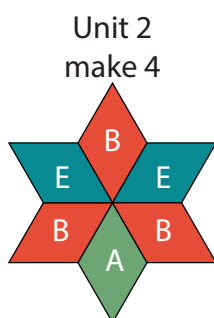

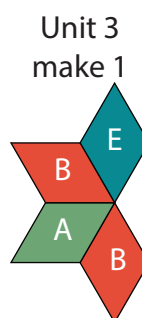

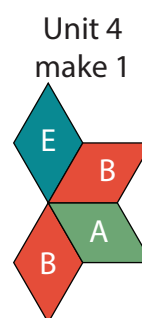

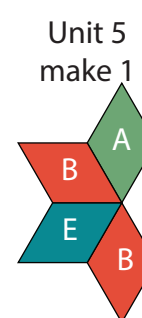

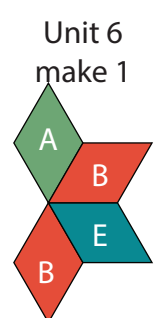

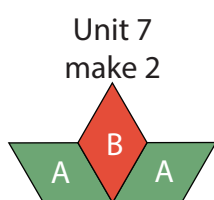

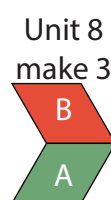

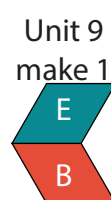

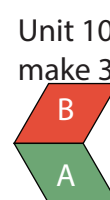

4. Refer to Figure 14 for shape/unit identification and placement to sew together the components as shown. Trim the newly sewn piece using the supplied Stocking Template 1 to make the Unit 12 piece.

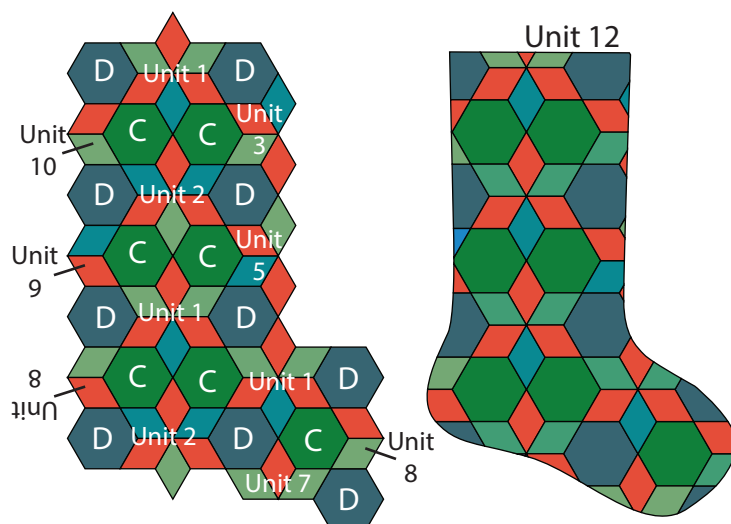

5. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figure 15 for shape/unit identification and placement to sew together the components as shown. Trim the newly sewn piece using the supplied Stocking Template 2 to make the Unit 13 piece.

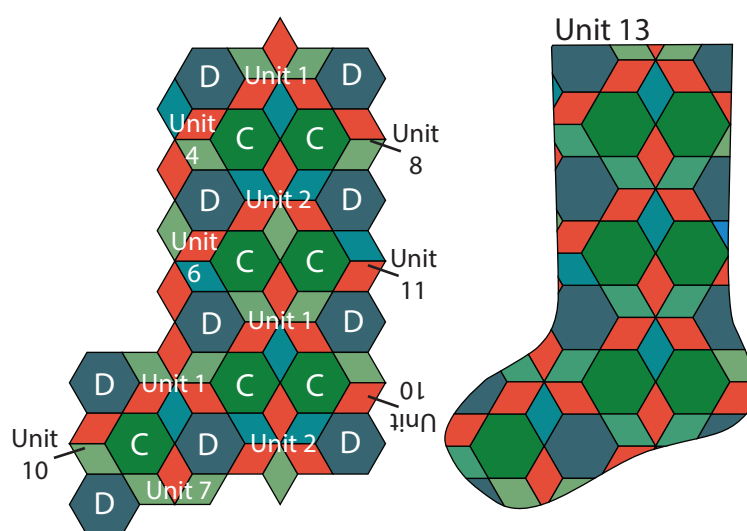

6. Sew (1) Fabric F Cuff #1 piece to the top of the Unit 12 piece to make the Unit 14 piece (Fig. 16).

7. Sew (1) Fabric F Cuff #2 piece to the top of the Unit 13 piece to make the Unit 15 piece (Fig. 16).

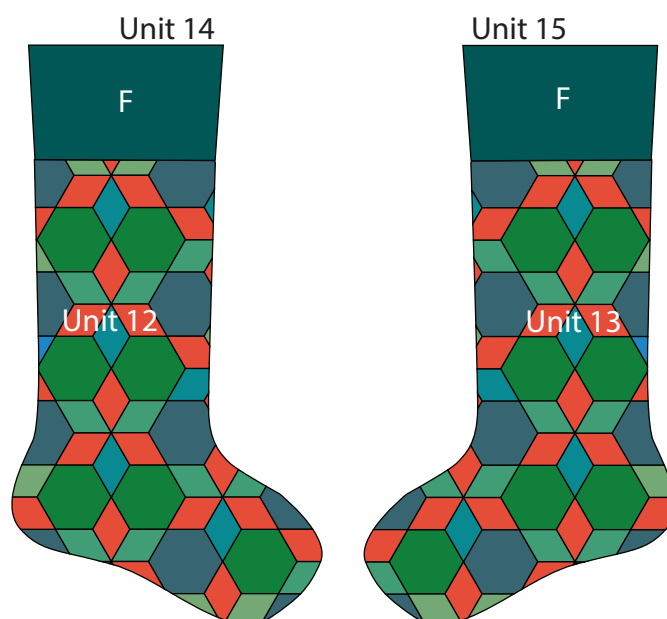

8. Sew (1) Fabric F Cuff #1 piece to the top of the Fabric F Stocking Template 1 piece to make the Unit 16 piece (Fig. 17).

9. Sew (1) Fabric F Cuff #2 piece to the top of the Fabric F Stocking Template 2 piece to make the Unit 17 piece (Fig. 17).

10. Layer the Unit 14 piece with a piece of batting and quilt as desired. Repeat with Unit 15 piece and remaining piece of batting.

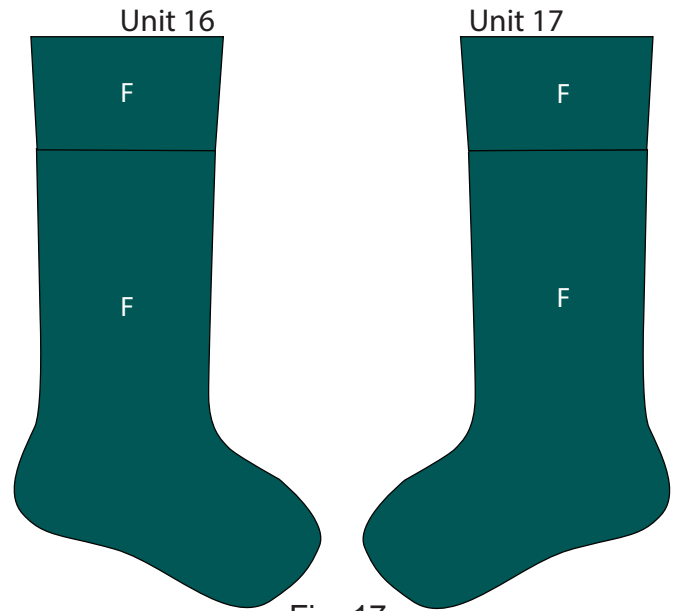

11. Place the Unit 14 piece and Unit 15 piece right sides together and sew around the (2) pieces leaving the top open to make the Unit 18 piece (Fig. 18).

12. Repeat Step 11 with the Unit 16 piece and Unit 17 piece to make the Unit 19 piece (Fig. 19).

13. Turn Unit 18 piece right side out and leave the Unit 19 piece inside out.

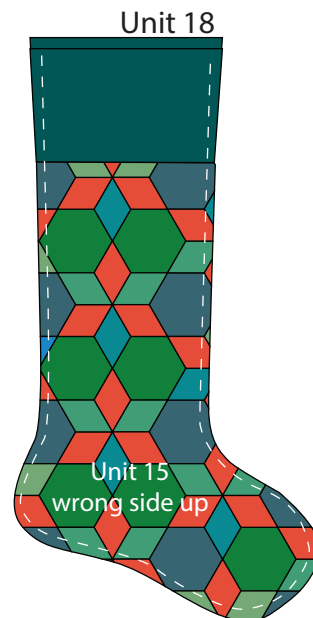

14. Slide the Unit 19 piece over the Unit 18 piece, right sides together (Fig. 20). Align the side seams and the top raw edges to pin the (2) pieces together.

15. Sew around the top of the (2) pieces to make Unit 20 (Fig. 20). Turn Unit 20 side out through the opening and press. Top stitch the opening closed.

16. Fold the cuff down over the stocking front to complete Stocking #1 (Fig. 21).

OPTIONAL: To add a hanger, decide where you would like the hanger to be on the stocking and open the seam in that area. Fold the ribbon or twine in half and slide the raw edges into the stocking. Top stitch over the opening to secure the hanger in place.

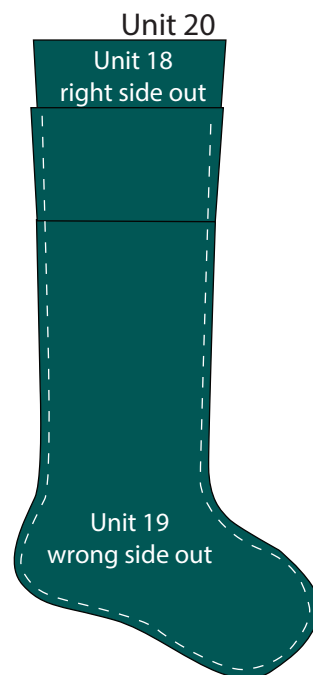

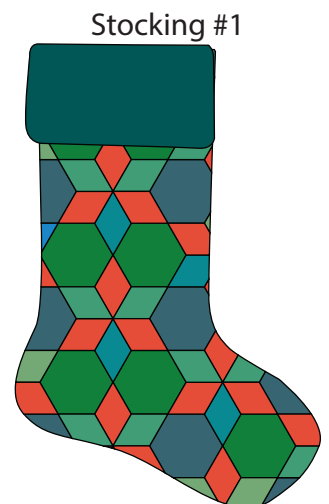

You will also need:

- (2) pieces of batting 35cm x 55cm for each stocking
- Basic sewing supplies and tools
- *Optional:* (1) 16cm piece of ribbon or twine for the hanger for each stocking

Cutting Instructions (Version #2): WOF/LOF = Width of Fabric/Length of Fabric

From the Stars and Ribbons - Green (A), cut:

- (32) Diamonds from template.

Candy Cane Stripe - Red (B), cut:

- (32) Diamonds from template.

Frosty Forest - Cream (C), cut:

- (14) Hexagons from template.

Snowy Rooftops - Green (D), cut:

- (20) Hexagons from template.

Ice Dancing - Blue (E), cut:

- (34) Diamonds from template.

Festive Flora - Blue (F), cut:

- (1) Stocking Template 1 piece and (1) Stocking Template 2 piece.
- (2) Cuff Template 1 pieces and (2) Cuff Template 2 pieces.

Sewing Instructions (Version #2):

Sew using a ¼" (0.64cm) seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise indicated. Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

17. Use the method of your choice listed below to prepare the listed number of Hexagons and Diamonds for the stocking of your choice.

- Sewing Method-Center and pin the cardstock template to the center of each fabric shape on the wrong side of the fabric. Fold over the fabric edge around the card stock and hand baste in place (Fig. 22).
- Gluing Method- Using a washable glue stick, center and glue the cardstock template to the center of each fabric shape on the wrong side of the fabric. Fold over the fabric edge around the card stock and glue in place with the glue stick.

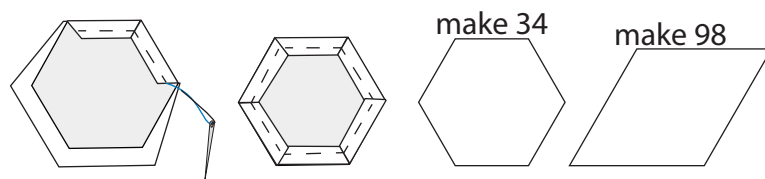

18. Place the first (2) Diamonds, right sides together aligning the edges. Start hand sewing the pieces together along the edges by placing two pieces right sides together and whip stitching them together, just catching the edges of the fabric. Recommended 6-10 stitches per inch (Fig 23).

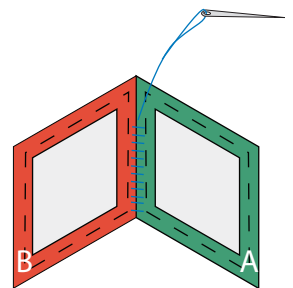

19. Refer to Figures 24-33 to make the indicated number of each unit piece for Unit 21 through Unit 30.

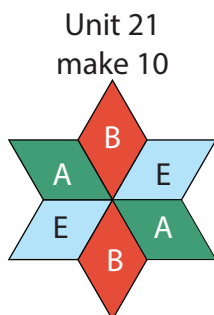

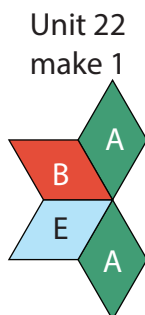

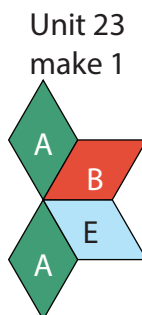

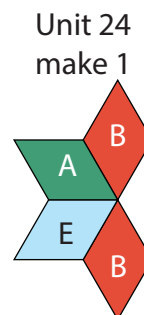

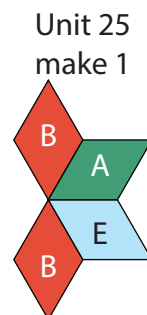

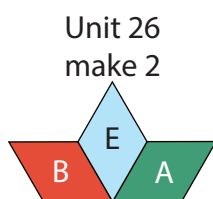

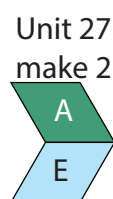

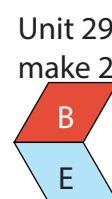

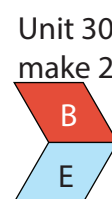

20. Refer to Figure 34 for shape/unit identification and placement to sew together the components as shown. Trim the newly sewn piece using the supplied Stocking Template 1 to make the Unit 31 piece.

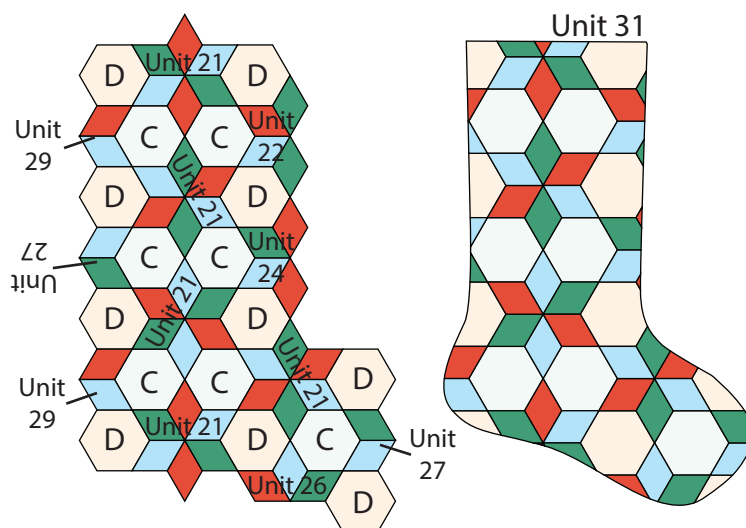

21. Repeat Step 20 and refer to Figure 35 for shape/unit identification and placement to sew together the components as shown. Trim the newly sewn piece using the supplied Stocking Template 2 to make the Unit 32 piece.

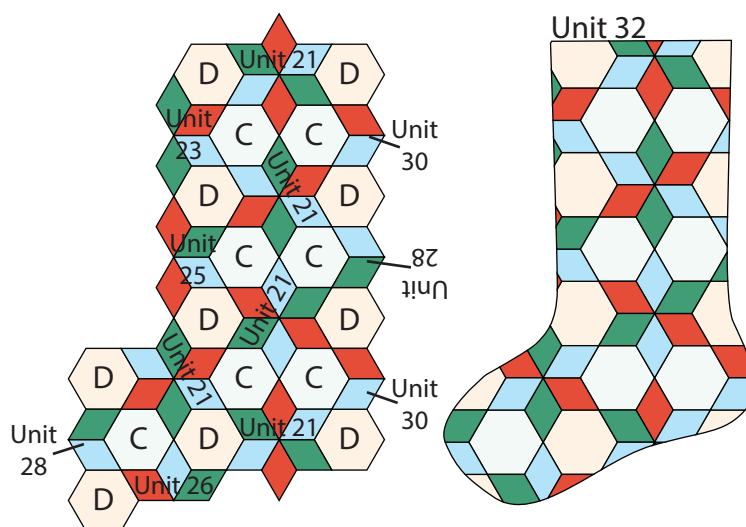

22. Sew (1) Fabric F Cuff #1 piece to the top of the Unit 24 piece to make the Unit 33 piece (Fig. 36).

23. Sew (1) Fabric F Cuff #2 piece to the top of the Unit 25 piece to make the Unit 34 piece (Fig. 36).

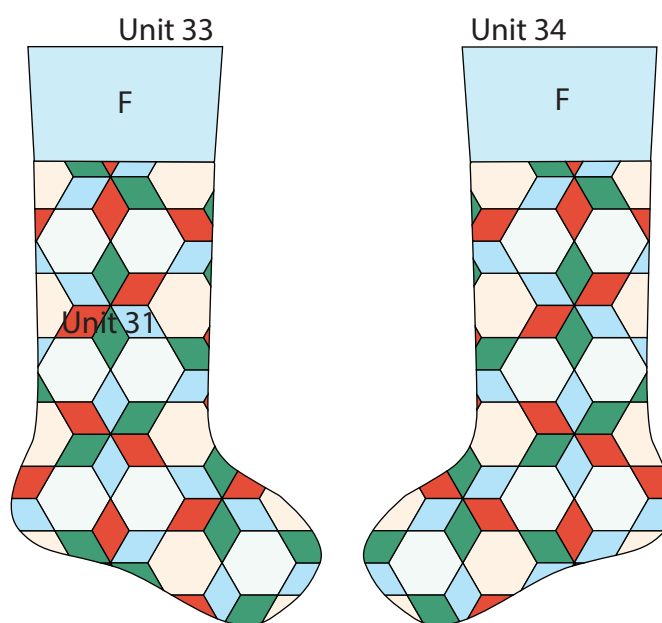

24. Sew (1) Fabric F Cuff #1 piece to the top of the Fabric F Stocking Template 1 piece to make the Unit 35 piece (Fig. 37).

25. Sew (1) Fabric F Cuff #2 piece to the top of the Fabric F Stocking Template 2 piece to make the Unit 36 piece (Fig. 37).

26. Layer the Unit 33 piece with a piece of batting and quilt as desired. Repeat with Unit 34 piece and remaining piece of batting.

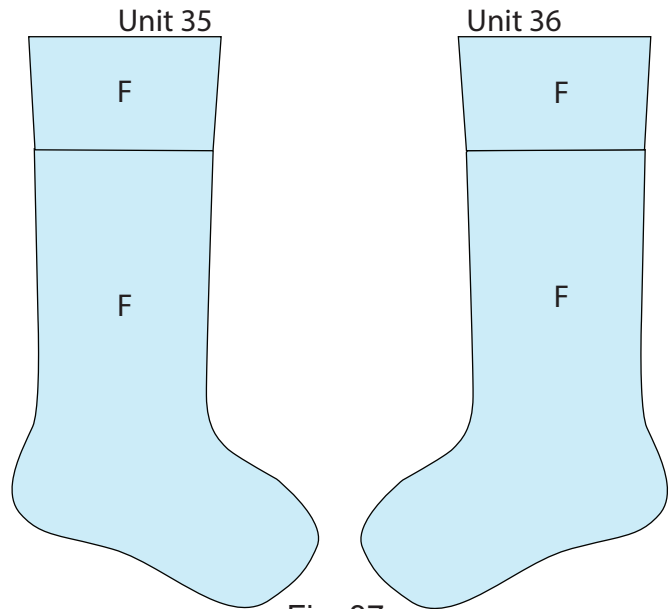

27. Place the Unit 33 piece and Unit 34 piece right sides together and sew around the (2) pieces leaving the top open to make the Unit 37 piece (Fig. 38).

28. Repeat Step 27 with the Unit 35 piece and Unit 36 piece to make the Unit 38 piece (Fig. 39).

29. Turn Unit 37 piece, right side out and leave the Unit 38 piece inside out.

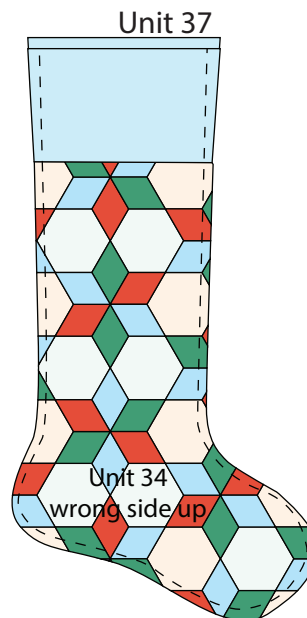

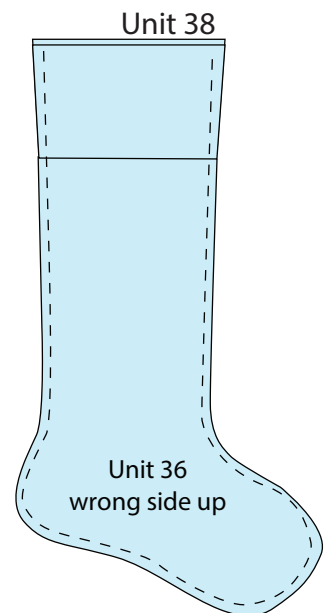

30. Slide the Unit 38 piece over the Unit 37 piece, right sides together (Fig. 40). Align the side seams and the top raw edges to pin the (2) pieces together.

31. Sew around the top of the (2) pieces to make Unit 39 (Fig. 40). Turn Unit 39 side out through the opening and press. Top stitch the opening closed.

32. Fold the cuff down over the stocking front to complete Stocking #2 (Fig. 21).

OPTIONAL: To add a hanger, decide where you would like the hanger to be on the stocking and open the seam in that area. Fold the ribbon or twine in half and slide the raw edges into the stocking. Top stitch over the opening to secure the hanger in place.

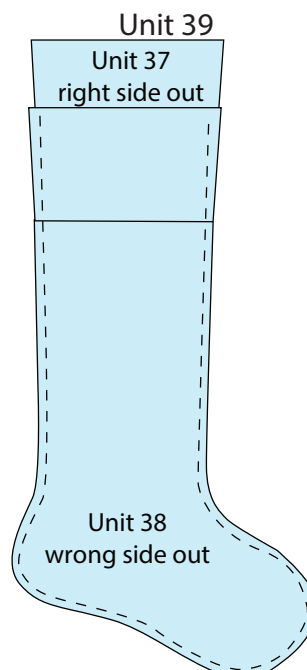

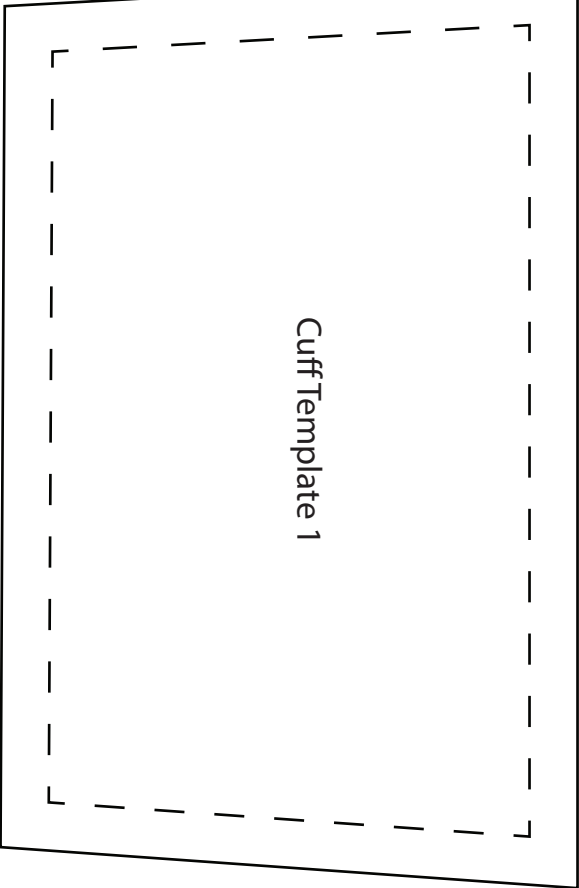
