You will also need:

- (1) piece of batting 58" x 72" (147cm x 183cm)
- Basic sewing supplies and tools

Cutting Instructions: WOF/LOF = Width of Fabric/Length of Fabric

Emolly Carousel – Blue (A), cut:

- (1) 5 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal from the upper left corner to the lower right corner to make (12) 5 ⅞" triangles.

Swirling Kaleidoscope – Blue (B), cut:

- (1) 6 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) 6 ¼" triangles.

Fun Fair Bunting – Blue (C), cut:

- (1) 5 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 5 ⅞" triangles.

Fairground Stripe – Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 6 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) 6 ¼" triangles. *Note: Due to the directional fabric, you will only use the top and bottom (12) 6 ¼" triangles.*

Festival Florals – Multi (E), cut:

- (1) 5 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 5 ⅞" triangles.

Fun Fair Bunting – Pink (F), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.
- (1) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ¾" squares.

Fairground Stripe – Pink (G), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

Emolly Carousel – Teal (H), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.
- (1) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ¾" squares.

Swirling Kaleidoscope – Teal (I), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

Festival Florals – Pink (J), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.
- (1) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ¾" squares.

Swirling Kaleidoscope – Red (K), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

Emolly Carousel – Red (L), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.
- (1) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ¾" squares.

Swirling Kaleidoscope – Brown (M), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

Festival Florals – Blue (N), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.
- (1) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ¾" squares.

Fairground Stripe – Teal (O), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

Fun Fair Bunting – Brown (P), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.
- (1) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ¾" squares.

Fairground Stripe – Red (Q), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Lassenby Silhouette – Cream (R), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (10) 2 ½" x 60 ½" length of fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (9) 6 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (36) 6 ¼" triangles.
- (12) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (288) 1 ¾" squares.


Back, cut:

- (2) 58" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 58" x 72" for the backing.




Sewing Instructions:

Sew using a ¼" (0.64cm) seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise indicated. The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.



1. Sew together (1) 6 ¼" Fabric B triangle and (1) 6 ¼" Fabric R triangle along short sides. Sew (1) 5 ⅞" Fabric A triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 5 ½" square. Repeat to make an additional (5) Block One squares.



2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Two squares, (12) Block Three squares and (12) Block Four squares.












3. Place (1) 1 ¾" Fabric R square on the top left corner of (1) 3" Fabric G square, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 6). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam.



4. Follow Figure 7 for the seam direction to add a 1 ¾" Fabric R square to the lower right corner and 1 ¾" Fabric F squares to the lower left and upper right corners of the 3" Fabric G square to make (1) Block Five square (Fig. 8).

5. Repeat Step 3-4 to make (11) additional Block Five squares.

6. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Figures 9-19 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (12) of each block square for Block Six through Block Sixteen.



7. Sew together (6) Block One squares and (6) Block Two squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make Column One (Fig. 20).
8. Sew together (12) Block Eleven squares and (12) Block Five squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make Column Two (Fig. 20).
9. Sew together (12) Block Twelve squares and (12) Block Six squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make Column Three (Fig. 20).
10. Sew together (12) Block Thirteen squares and (12) Block Seven squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make Column Four (Fig. 20).
11. Sew together (12) Block Three squares, alternating the orientation from top to bottom, to make Column Five (Fig. 20).
12. Sew together (12) Block Fourteen squares and (12) Block Eight squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make Column Six (Fig. 20).
13. Sew together (12) Block Fifteen squares and (12) Block Nine squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make Column Seven (Fig. 20).
14. Sew together (12) Block Sixteen squares and (12) Block Ten squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make Column Eight (Fig. 20).
15. Sew together (12) Block Four squares, alternating the orientation from top to bottom, to make Column Nine (Fig. 20).
16. Sew together the (9) pieced columns in numerical order and (8) 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" Fabric R strips, alternating them from left to right, to make the 46 1/2" x 60 1/2" Quilt Center (Fig. 20).




Quilt Top Assembly: Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.

17. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric R strip to each side of the Quilt Center.
18. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric R strip to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.
19. Layer and quilt as desired.
20. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric Q strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
21. Bind as desired.
