Finished Quilt Top Dimensions - 60" x 60"

Fabric Requirements

One layer cake or a (fat or long) quarter of each of the 20 prints in the Summer Fair collection

1 fat quarter or long quarter of the following 9 blender prints

- Wiltshire Shadow Royal Blue
- Emily Belle Blue Sky
- Wiltshire Shadow Peony Blush
- Wiltshire Shadow Ruby
- Wiltshire Shadow Raspeberry
- Emily Belle Vintage Pink
- Wiltshire Shadow Lemon
- Wiltshire Shadow Putty
- York Fern Apple Leaf

Background fabric - 3 and 5/8 yards of Lasenby Silhouette - Garden Walk

Binding - 1/2 yard of Lasenby Silhouette - Garden Walk

Backing - 2 yards of Emily Blossom - Crimson Red 107" wideback






Cutting


	Shape	Number of Pieces to cut
Block piece A	Template A	180 - see Block Piece A Cutting Chart
Block piece B	Template B	36
Block piece C	Template C	36
Sashing piece D	1" X 19" strip	12
Sashing piece E	1" X 1" square	4
Border piece F^	57" X 1.75" strip	2
Border piece G^	60" X 1.75" strip	2

^Join 2 WOF x 1.75" strips and trim to finished piece size







Piecing


- Using the pattern cover as a guide for each block, lay out your “Block piece A” pieces in the order shown.




- Separate the pieces into 4 groups of 5 pieces. Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, sew the 5 pieces in each group together along their long edge. Press your seams open.




3. Sew block piece B to the outer edge of each quadrant using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Clip seam 3-5 times making sure not to cross over the thread line. Press seam open.
4. Sew block piece C to the inner edge of each quadrant using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Clip seam 2-3 times making sure not to cross over the thread line. Press seam open.



5. Lay out block pieces like the diagram below. Sew together 2 top pieces using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and press seams open. Repeat for 2 bottom pieces.




6. Sew together the top and bottom half of the block using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and press seam open.



7. Repeat steps 1 through 7 for all 9 blocks.


8. Lay out the first row of blocks with sashing piece D between each block like in the diagram below. Sew together blocks and sashing using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press open seams. Repeat for the 3 rows of blocks.



9. Lay out a row of sashing with sashing piece E between 3 of sashing piece D like in the diagram below. Sew together sashing pieces using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and press open seams. Repeat to make another joined sashing row.







10. Sew together block rows and sashing rows using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance referring to the diagram below. Press seams open.



11. Sew the first Border piece F to the right side of the quilt top using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and press seam open.

12. Sew the second Border piece F to the left side of the quilt top using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and press seam open.
13. Sew the first Border piece G to the top edge of the quilt top using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and press seam open.
14. Sew the second Border piece G to the bottom edge of the quilt top using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and press seam open.
