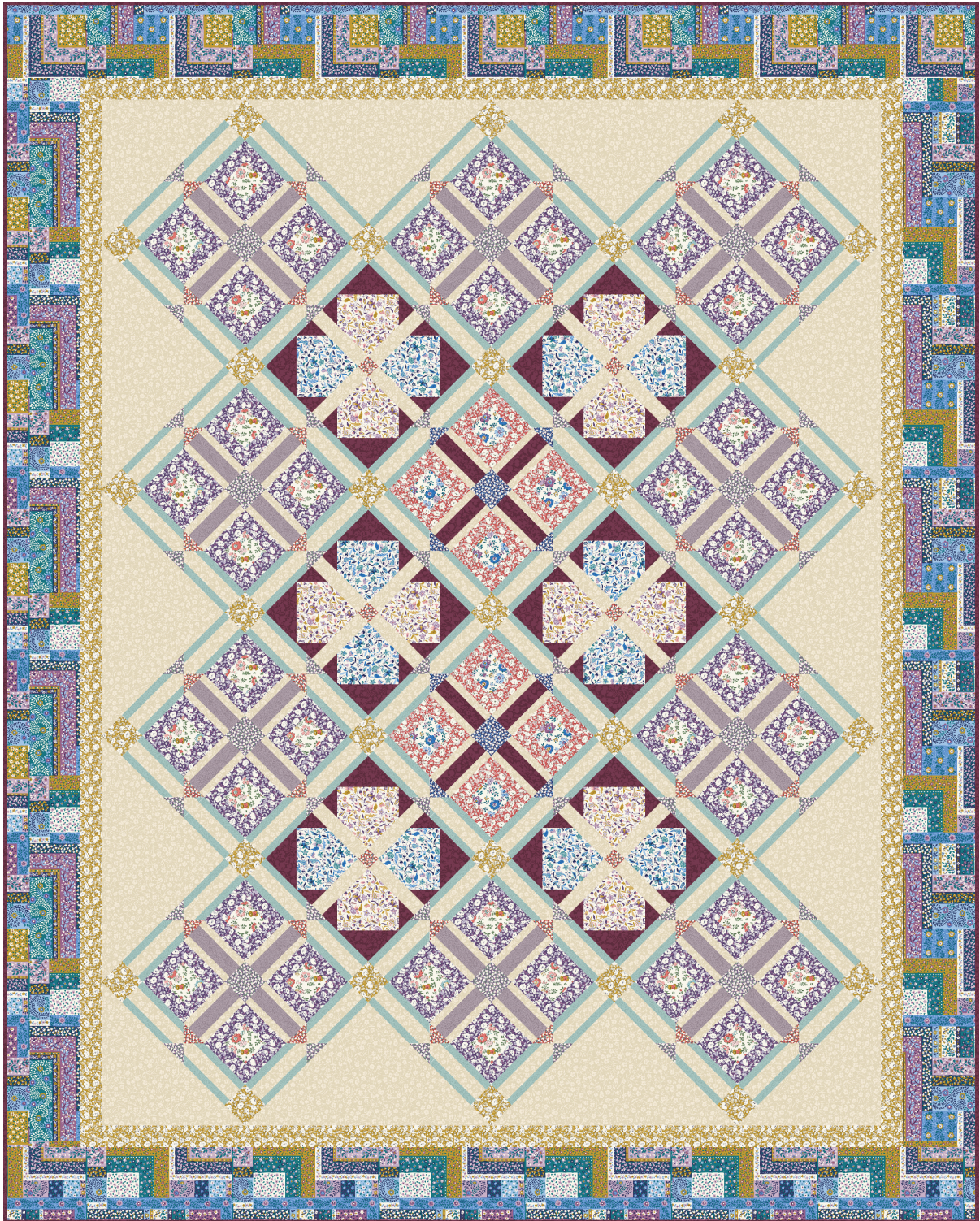


Tudor Celebration

York Fern Duck Egg Blue (F)	$\frac{7}{8}$ yard (0.80m)	016668104A

You will also need:

- (1) piece of batting 70" x 80" (178cm x 203cm)
- Basic sewing supplies and tools

Cutting Instructions: WOF/LOF = Width of Fabric/Length of Fabric

Haberdashery Floral - Coral (A), cut:

- (3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Mayflower Meadow - Purple (B), cut:

- (5) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (9) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Haberdashery Floral - Blue (C), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Mayflower Meadow - Coral (D), cut:

- (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

August Meadow Magnolia (E), cut:

- (14) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.
- (12) 1" x WOF strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" strips.
- (2) 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (3) 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make (12) 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (10) 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.*
- (1) 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Cut each square across (1) diagonal to make (4) 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ " triangles.

York Fern Duck Egg Blue (F), cut:

- (28) 1" x WOF strips.

Tudor Tumble - Coral (G), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (86) 1 ½" squares.

Tudor Tumble - Purple (H), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 ½" squares.

Tudor Tumble - Blue (I), cut:

- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" squares.

York Fern Wisteria Purple (J), cut:

- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips.

Wiltshire Shadow Blackcurrant (K), cut:

- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip.
- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 ½" squares.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2" squares.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Quilt Nouveau - Blue (L), cut:

- (2) 5" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 5" squares.

Quilt Nouveau - Purple (M), cut:

- (2) 5" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 5" squares.

Mayflower Meadow - Gold (N), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) 2 ½" squares.
- (7) 2" x WOF strips.

Patchwork Scarves - Blue/Multi (O), cut:

- (8) 5 ½" x WOF strips.

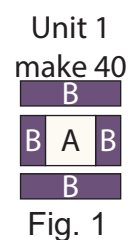
Emily Blossom - Marine Blue 108" (Back), cut:

- (1) 69" x 92" strip.

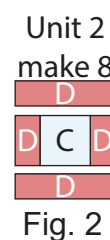
Sewing Instructions:

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " (0.64cm) seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise indicated. Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

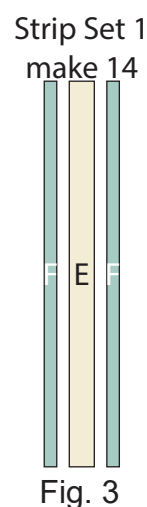
1. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square to the (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (40) Unit 1 squares total.



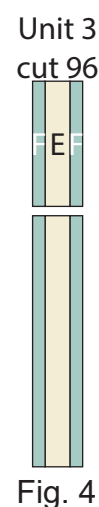
2. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric C square to the (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (8) Unit 2 squares total.



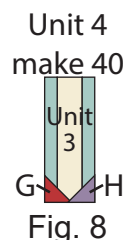
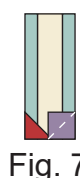
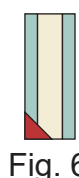
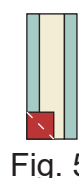
3. Sew (1) 1" x WOF Fabric F strip to each side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric E strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (14) Strip Set 1's total.



4. Cut the (7) Strip Set 1's into (96) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 3 strips (Fig. 4).



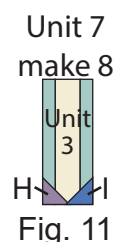
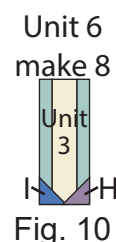
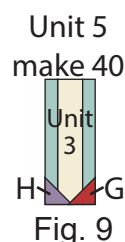
5. Place (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square on the bottom left corner of (1) Unit 3 strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 6).



6. Follow Figure 7 for the seam direction to add a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square to the bottom right corner of the Unit 3 strip to make (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 4 strip (Fig. 8).

7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (40) Unit 4 strips total.

8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figures 9-11 for unit and fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (40) Unit 5 strips, (8) Unit 6 strips and (8) Unit 7 strips.



9. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to the top of (1) Unit 5 strip to make (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Unit 8 strip (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (40) Unit 8 strips total.

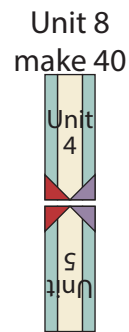

10. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to the top of (1) Unit 7 strip to make (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Unit 9 strip (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (8) Unit 9 strips total.

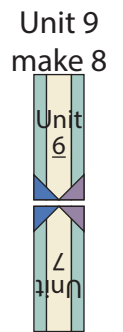


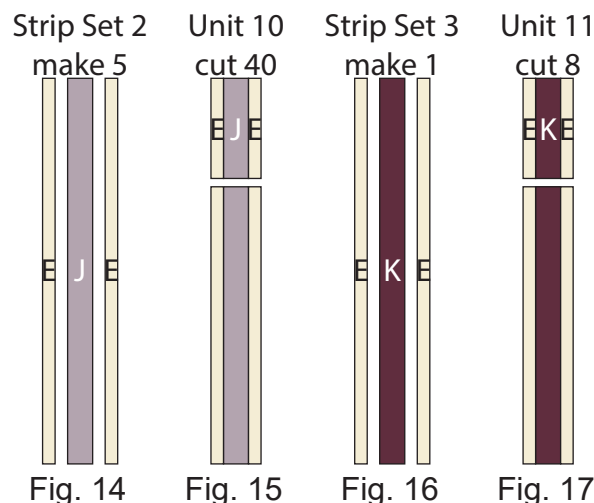

11. Sew (1) 1" x WOF Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 1 ½" x WOF Fabric J strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 2 (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (5) Strip Set 2's total.

12. Cut the (5) Strip Set 2's into (40) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Unit 10 strips (Fig. 15).

13. Sew (1) 1" x WOF Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 1 ½" x WOF Fabric K strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 3 (Fig. 16).

14. Cut the Strip Set 3 into (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Unit 11 strips (Fig. 17).



15. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) Unit 10 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 10 strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric H square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 ½" Unit 12 square (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (10) Unit 12 squares total.

16. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each side of (1) Unit 11 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 11 strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric I square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 ½" Unit 13 square (Fig. 19). Repeat to make a second Unit 13 square.

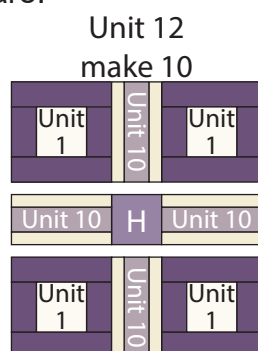

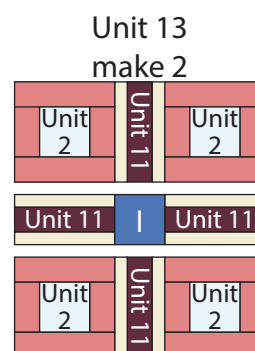

17. Sew (1) Unit 8 strip to each side of (1) Unit 12 square. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric N square to each end of (1) Unit 8 strip. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of the Unit 12 square lengthwise to make (1) 14 ½" x 12 ½" Block One rectangle (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (10) Block One rectangles total.

18. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to each side of (1) Unit 13 square. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric N square to each end of (1) Unit 9 strip. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of the Unit 13 square lengthwise to make (1) 14 ½" x 12 ½" Block Two rectangle (Fig. 21). Repeat to make a second Block Two rectangle.

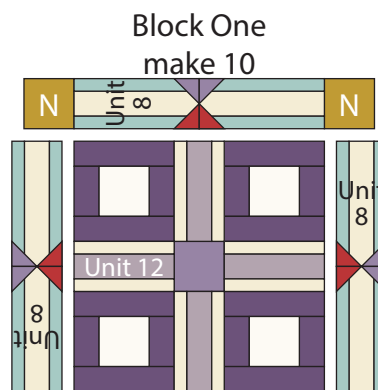

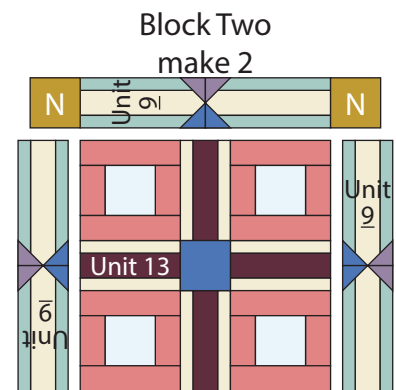

19. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric K square on the top left corner of (1) 5" Fabric L square, right sides together (Fig. 22). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 22). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 23).

20. Follow Figure 24 for the seam direction to add a 2" Fabric K square to the lower left and upper right corners of the 5" Fabric L square to make (1) Unit 14 square (Fig. 25).

21. Repeat Steps 19-20 to make (12) 5" Unit 14 squares total.

22. Repeat Steps 19-20 and refer to Figure 26 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (12) Unit 15 squares.

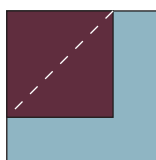

23. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 5" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 1 ½" Fabric G square to make (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Unit 16 strip (Fig. 27). Repeat to make (6) Unit 16 strips total.

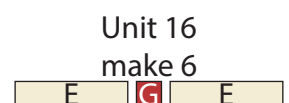

24. Sew together (1) Unit 14 square, (1) 1 ½" x 5" Fabric E strip and (1) Unit 15 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row. Sew together (1) Unit 15 square, (1) 1 ½" x 5" Fabric E strip and (1) Unit 14 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row. Sew together the top row, (1) Unit 16 strip and the bottom row, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) 10 ½" Unit 17 square (Fig. 28). Repeat to make (6) Unit 17 square total.

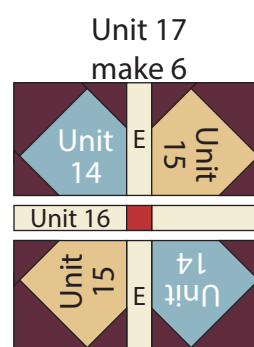

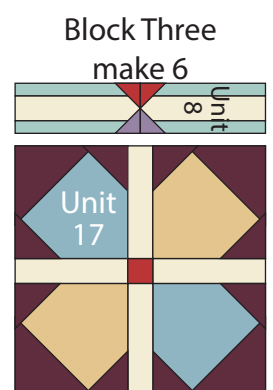

25. Sew (1) Unit 8 strip to the top of (1) Unit 17 square to make (1) 10 ½" x 12 ½" Block Three rectangle (Fig. 29). Repeat to make (6) Block Three rectangles total.

26. Sew together (1) 2 ½" Fabric N square, (1) Unit 8 strip, (1) 2 ½" Fabric N square, (1) Unit 8 strip, (1) 2 ½" Fabric N square, (1) Unit 9 strip, (1) 2 ½" Fabric N square, (1) Unit 9 strip, (1) 2 ½" Fabric N square, (1) Unit 8 strip, (1) 2 ½" Fabric N square, (1) Unit 8 strip and (1) 2 ½" Fabric N square, end to end and in that order from left to right, to make the 2 ½" x 74 ½" Block Four strip (Fig. 30).

27. Sew (1) 18 ¼" Fabric E triangle to each side of (1) Block One rectangle. Sew (1) 10 ¾" Fabric E triangle to the top of the Block One rectangle to make Row One (Fig. 31).

28. Repeat Step 27 and refer to Figure 31 for unit and fabric identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Six.

29. Sew together Row One, Row Two, Row Three, the Block Four strip, Row Four, Row Five and Row Six, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Unit 18 piece (Fig. 31).

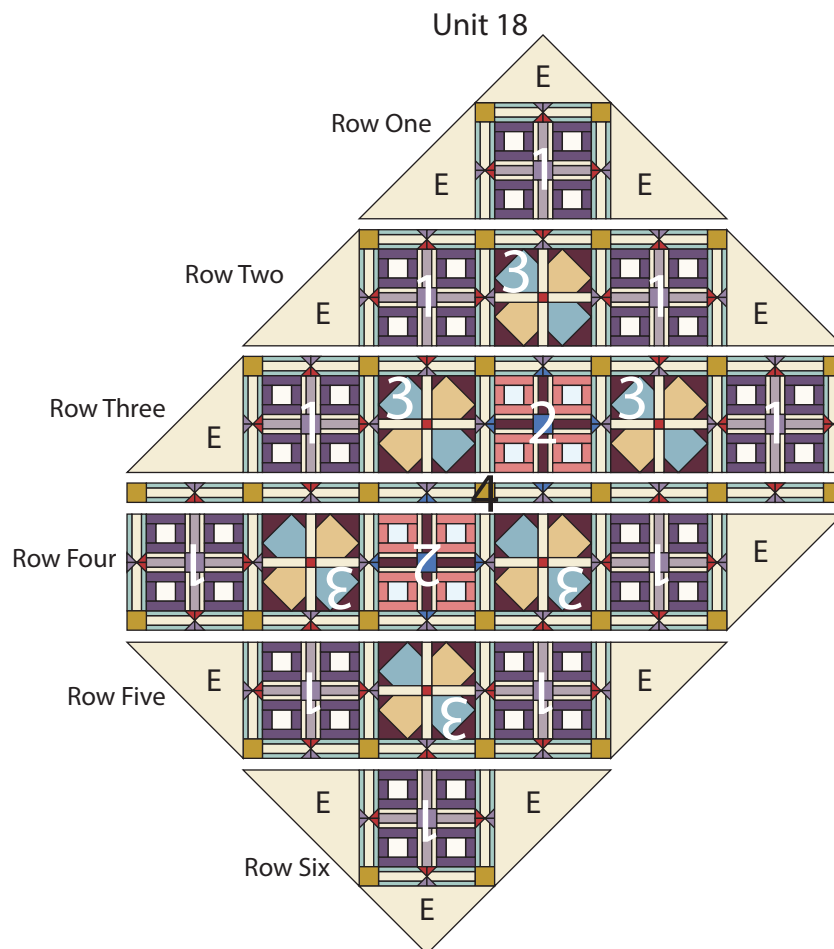

30. Sew (1) 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric E triangle to the left and right sides of the Unit 18 piece to make the Center Block (Fig. 32).

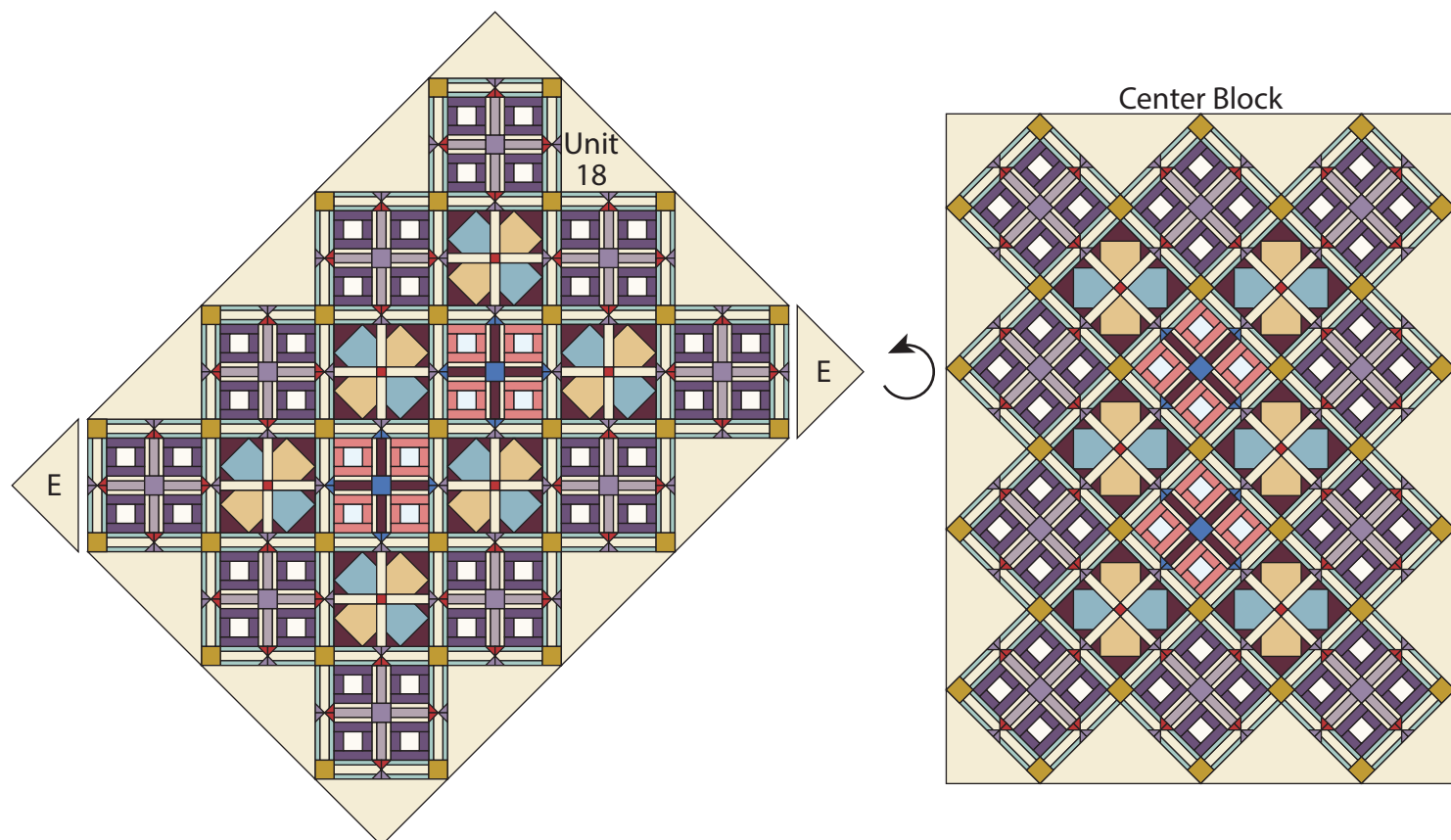

Quilt Top Assembly: Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.

31. Measure the sides of the Center Block. Sew together (4) 2" x WOF Fabric N strips end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) strips to the side measurements. Sew (1) newly cut strip to each side of the Center Block.

32. Measure the top and bottom of the Center Block including the Fabric N side borders. Sew together (3) 2" x WOF Fabric N strips end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) strips to the top and bottom measurements. Sew (1) newly cut strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.

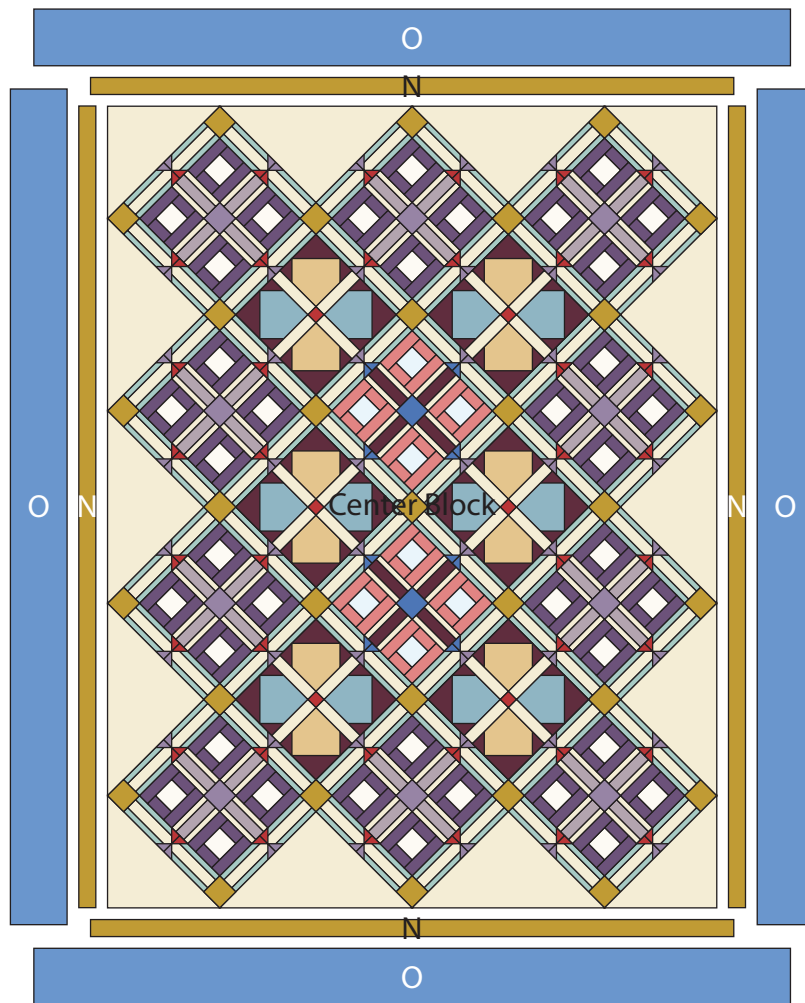
33. Measure the sides of the Center Block. Sew together (4) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric O strips end to end and cut (2) strips to the side measurements. Sew (1) newly cut strip to each side of the Center Block.

34. Measure the top and bottom of the Center Block including the Fabric O side borders. Sew together (4) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric O strips end to end and cut (2) strips to the top and bottom measurements. Sew (1) newly cut strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

35. Layer and quilt as desired.

36. Sew the (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric K strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

37. Bind as desired.
